TRAVEL

Airports

Ground Transportation

The Chicago Transit Authority (CTA/elevated/"el") train provides rapid transit service to downtown. There is an "el" stop at the O'Hare airport. Please visit [CTA Trip Planner](#) for detailed directions to your destination.

Average taxicab fare from O'Hare or Midway to Wieboldt Hall is approximately \$30 one way. You can also use rideshare apps (such as Uber or Lyft) for \$30-\$50 one way.

Renting a car may be your preferred choice for ground transportation, and you will find various car rental services located at each airport. Please note traffic and street parking downtown are unpredictable, and you should allow adequate time for travel and parking. There are several public parking garages available to visitors of Northwestern near Wieboldt Hall, and you can view a printable parking map [here](#).
